

TIPS FOR PRINTING & USE:

If possible, print on card stock and laminate or cover with clear contact paper for durability.

Ideas for use:

- 1. Give each player a vertical board from pages 3 to 7 and eight marker cards from page 13.
- 2. Shuffle the cards from pages 8 to 12, and place in a deck, face-down.
- 3. On each turn, players draw the top card and read all 4 words on the front, calling special attention to the 2 words with the /ou/ sound.
- 4. After reading the words, the player looks for the 2 /ou/ words from the card on their playing board. If there is a match, the space is covered.
- 5. The winner is the first to cover all 8 spaces on their playing board.
- 6. Cards can also be used for reading apart from the game, for finding rhymes, inspiring creative writing, for oral spelling practice, etc.
